Historical Details of the Malayil Family Branch

1 Malayil Tharian (*Generation 1*)

16 Kunjummen, youngest son of Malayil Tharian (*Generation 2*).

Kunjummen was born in 1015. Though he received only elementary education, he had a thirst for reading and learning. In the year 1032, he married Annamma, daughter of Memuriyil Mathen (Elanthoor), and accepted the ancestral house to be home.

A radiant and well built personality, Kunjummen had the gift to execute matters with skill. He was concerned about matters of the church. After his father's death, he was elected as Church Warden of the Kuzhikala Church, a responsibility which he held till death. It was during this period that he gave lead for the construction of the Primary School, Punnackad. He was a model for simple lifestyle and piety. The family has 5 sons and 3 daughters.

Kunjummen passed away at the age of 45, on 8 Kanni 1060. His wife Annamma, a lady with many gifts, expired on 24 Vrichikom 1094, at the age of 78.

161 Tharian Karingolickal, eldest son of

Malayil Kunjummen (*Generation 3*).

Tharian, at the age of 14, married Aleyamma, daughter of Puthuchira Mannil Koshy. After his father's death, he assumed responsibility as Warden of the Kuzhikala Church. The desire and need for a church at Punnackad started to materialise with the purchase of land and start of construction in 1082. Co-operation of the members of the Malayil family and other families helped completion of the Church in 1083; the service that has been going on in the school since 1035 was shifted the new Church.

The need for a cemetery was the next challenge. Tharian brought the Kochooti Melethethil plot in his own name, and transferred ownership to the Church. Another 50 cents of land at the Chempikara plot was sold at a nominal price to build a church. Tharian was concerned about maintaining unity among members of the Malayil family. 7 of the members in this generation and 1 son-in-law joined hands to buy a 92 acre plot at Kallelil, which was an effort towards unity, earning the name *Ettuveeder* (The 8-fold family), to them, as they came to known in different parts of Kerala. Tharian passed away in December 1947, at the age of 85. Aleyamma's demise, at 81, was in January 1946. The family has 4 daughters and 4 sons.

1611 Annamma

In the year 1077, at the age of 14, Annamma was married to Anickad Thomas (Edayaranmula).

1612 Kunjummen (Kunju), eldest son of Tharian.

Kunju married Annamma, daughter of Anickad Mathai (Edayaranmula) in 1082. The family shifted to Theverkattil in 1094. He has rendered valuable service to the church and the land. Since 1109, he has been involved in various callings such as member of committee of the CMS Church, Diocesan Council and Standing Committee, and also as Church Warden and member of the Kudumbayogam Committee. He was also member of the *Desaabhivrudini Sangom* Committee. The chancel of the Church was built during his period of involvement. He was also instrumental in the purchase of the plot on which was constructed the CSI Hospital. He passed away on 31 October 1979, and Annamma on 6 November 1986. They have 7 daughters and 2 sons.

16121 Aleyamma

In Makarom 1104, Aleyamma was married to Thadisseril Philip (Kidanganloor). Not long after, Philip died, and Aleyamma was married again, to Kalayil Luckose (Thumpamon) in Thulam 1111.

16122 Very Rev. K. K. Tharian, B.A., STM (*Generation 5*)

Tharian took his Intermediate from the UC College, Aluva, and his B. A. from the University of Calcutta.

After his Intermediate, he attended classes on British Survey. He served in the Military, from which he returned after World War II.

He was selected for theological studies in 1948, and was ordained Presbyter in 1952. He has served in the churches of Kattanam, Cathedral, Thiruvalla, Pallom and Kuzhikala. He was also Chaplain of CMS College. He took his STM from America in 1961. Achen was appointed as Diocesan Treasurer in 1968. He was also member of the CSI Synod. After retirement in 1979, he served as President of the Malayil Kudumbayogam. On 7 February 1946, he married Aleyamma, daughter of Parambil Varughese (Puthenkavu). Aleyamma passed away on 22 November 1991, and Achen on 8 March 1998. The family has 3 sons and 1 daughter.

On 21 August 1967, he married Gracy (M.Sc.), daughter of Kayyalath Philip (Mallappally). Gracy has served as lecturer in the St. Stephen's College, Pathanapuram.

She took her MS and BS (Computer) degrees from the Boston College, America, which she joined in 1968. She is currently Software Engineer at Famingham State College. The family has 1 son and 1 daughter.

16185 Varughese (Moni), son of Tharian (*Generation 5*).

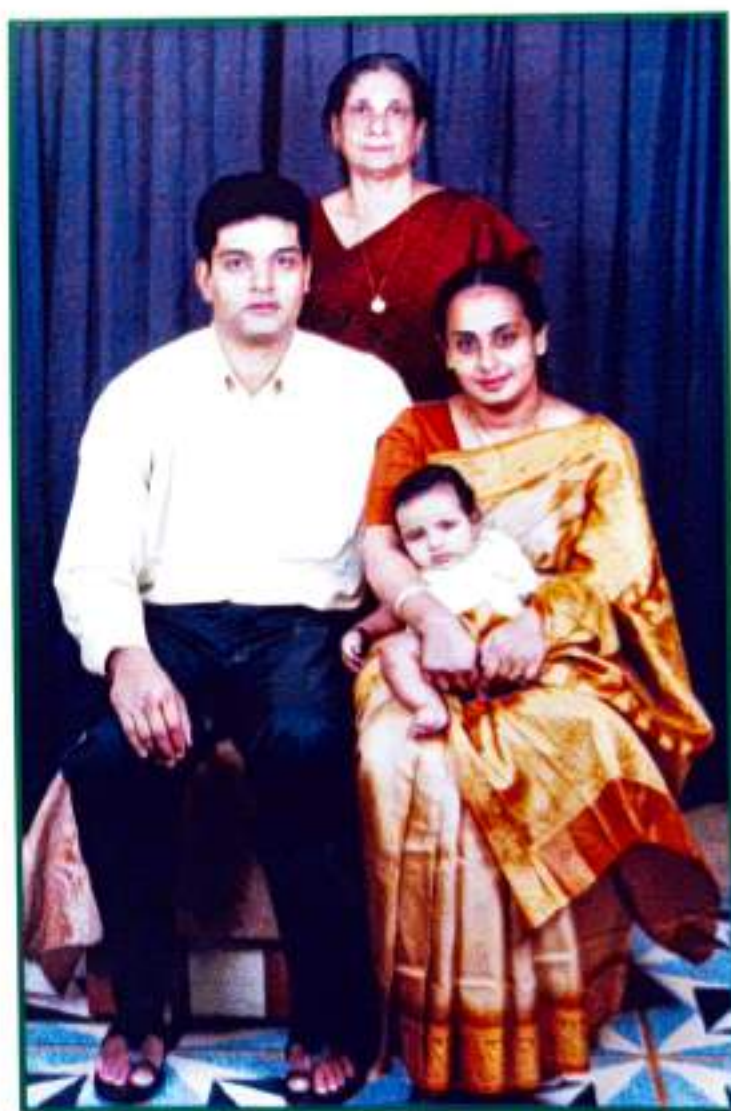
